### Remembering Josephine Todaro Beloved Advocate, Colleague, and Friend

We are heartbroken to share the passing of Josephine Todaro on June 1, 2025. Josephine was a cherished part of the RCAL family for decades and a powerful force in the independent living movement across New York State.

A ferocious advocate for people with disabilities, Josephine was particularly instrumental in advancing the rights of individuals living with Traumatic

Brain Injuries (TBI). At RCAL, she led our TBI Support Group with compassion, honesty, and unwavering dedication—creating a safe, empowering space for countless individuals over the years.

In 2020, Josephine brought her talents to the New York Association on Independent Living (NYAIL), where she helped launch the statewide Good Neighbor Program. Despite the sudden onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, which dramatically reshaped the work, Josephine was undaunted. Her deep background in case management and her hands-on approach made her an incredible asset. She saw every individual in the program as "My Neighbor"—and treated them with dignity, care, and fierce loyalty.



One Transition Specialist shared, "Josephine was always helpful and willing to jump in and get her hands dirty with a tough case."

Even as her health declined, Josephine remained committed to her work. She personally helped interview her successor, ensuring the program would remain in strong hands. Her dedication never wavered.

Josephine's strong New York City accent, spirited attitude, and no-nonsense approach to advocacy made her unforgettable. Her legacy will live on through the lives she touched and the systems she helped shape. Rest in power, Josephine. Your voice and your fight will never be forgotten.


